Parent Coordinator's Report - Stephen McGill via Bob Bender in Stephen's absence

- 5th Grade parents: Middle school applicants need a myschool account to apply. Enrollment office isn't issuing creation codes until they decide on an application process and admissions criteria. When info is available, it will be emailed directly home (not PS11), so please email Stephen and Phyllis if you need to update your contact info (email, address etc.) immediately
- School has no info on G&T testing application timeline, Kindergarten Pre-K application sign up for alerts on DOE website.
- Transcript request info or teacher recommendation for private schools: please forward transcript requests to
 Phyllis and allow 2-4 weeks. Bob is not asking teachers to write recommendations at this time. They are receiving
 many requests and it is unmanageable at this time.

Principal's Report - Bob Bender

- Bob doesn't know much. Rumors are that schools are closed through Thanksgiving, no official notice.
- Bob is very honored and proud of all the teachers and office staff for the systems that have put in place for the transitioning between blended and remote.
- About 80 students have opted back in. No changes were required in cohorts assignments, classrooms, and programming..
- 2 classes have to move rooms, (1st grade g&t, 3rd grade g&t)
- Planning for a November 30th return with new blended students. Cohort assignments are not flexible.
- Health Screening has been updated with new travel quarantine requirements.
- Bob will be checking the covid tests. Please be honest on the health screener, Bob has caught some families who
 have been dishonest. Reminder that kids are now eating inside due to the weather and higher risk. Please be
 careful!

- There are rumors that students coming in to the building will be required to sign a permission slip allowing for random covid tests (right now less than 50% of students at ps11 have signed the permission slip)
- Please be mindful that everything has been carefully planned with consistency and continuity in mind for students, families and teachers. While school decisions may feel questionable, there are reasons and Bob is happy to disclose the thinking behind them.
- Rumor (from a very involved NEST parent) that DOE hasn't signed a contract with the G&T testing company -Bob has never heard that rumor
- District 2 Superintendent has resigned. IF you have signed up for blended BUT do not plan to send your child in to school now, PLEASE Communicate with Bob and be truthful.
