

### Welcome / Approval of 1/22/21 minutes

## Principal's Report - Bob Bender

- Covid there was another case at school. The process is as follows: Bob files a report to the situation room and files a categorized close contact list (which requires 10 min of total exposure time), Bob waits for the list of people who must quarantine. Bob will speak to all families who need to quarantine BEFORE the form letter is sent out
- Parent teacher conferences next week
