Approval of May minutes

- Mask mandate is still in effect at school, and at school property outdoor and indoor
- Every grade will have 3 days of substitutes teachers while teachers plan for next year's curriculum

Principal's Report - Bob Bender

- A lot to go over but nothing is finalized and we will find out over the summer
- 8:25am-2:45 pending approval (2:40 for K and 1st graders)
- Anyone on school property will be required to wear a mask and 3' social distancing 6' for unmasked/eating
- No news about not requiring masks outdoors (similar to summer camps)
- Kids will not be meeting their next year teachers this school year due to uncertainty about social distancing rules
- Meet your teacher day is a very special at PS11. If the social distancing guidelines don't change over the summer
 Bob will be sending out new classroom info over the summer
- Mid 2022 is the projected end date for school construction and hopefully by then the student name change committee will have selected a new name for PS11 and we can have a grand unveiling event
- I couldn't have gone through this year without the support from the PTA, SLT, and all the school families. Thank you from the bottom of my heart.
- Parent Question: Can the play structure be accessible? Answer: Large play structure (2 slides) is broken and cannot be used. If there is a way to isolate the slides we may be able to use the play structure
- No changes to current G&T programming for the students. Only the incoming policy has changed (no testing and based on teacher recommendations instead). Offers will only go out for 1st, 2nd and 3rd graders if they were on the waitlist last year (over the next 2-3 wks). Week of July 5th for kindergarten offers. Additional teachers may be needed with 3' distancing for G&T classrooms. We are having a budget meeting later today. More info to follow

- We are in pretty good shape for next year because our expenses were low
- We will re-evaluate the budget in the fall and present it to you again then, depending on the climate of the school year
- We are carrying over money and thus will be presented as a negative budget
- Annual fundraiser will read lower on the budget compared to normal year
- Budget Presentation (Monica)
 - o 'Gross' is all the money that comes in, and 'Net' is how much we have left after all expenses
 - All line items having been added back with assumption that everything will be back in full swing
- Bob is also carrying over money in his account from last year
