Principal's Report - Bob Bender

- We are a Kind, Gentle and Grateful School
- Moment of Gratitude observed
- As of Tuesday, all DOE staff members must have at least one vaccination. 100% of our teachers meet this
 requirement.
- Up to 30,000 employees are expected to be released. Will not greatly impact our school and district
- Quarantine procedure no longer closing classrooms when there is a positive case. Waiting for more but specific information from our emergency meeting with Chancellor today at 1pm
- Arrival and Dismissal Afterschool will start Monday 27th and it will make dismissal much easier (less students).
 Thank you for all of the cooperation thus far
- Many kids are arriving after 8:30 please do your best to arrive on time. Students may miss up to 15-20 of school as they need to be taken to the cafeteria and wait for an adult pickup.
- After many concerns from the parents, lunch is being eaten outside, and is working out well. It's not perfect but it's working.
 - Lower playground has been dedicated to organized group play by Debbie. Encourage your kids to participate as it lowers possible accidents
- Curriculum night coming up Sept 30. Grade level teams will be presenting and then break out rooms with your teacher. Apologies if you have multiple children (you will have to choose one and will not be recorded)
- Specialty Teacher presentations Oct 5th
- Mosquitos are an issue in NYC right now. Staff are working on mitigation by bleaching the storm drains twice a
 week, and checking for standing water. If you are still concerned please consider applying bug spray before your
 kids arrive at school
- Please send your child with a full water bottle and encourage them NOT to drink all their water at once, this wasn't a problem pre-covid when water fountains were being used.
 - Debbie is working on getting water but for the time being, consider sending your child with 2 bottles or, your child can ask their teacher for a refill
- IF DOE quarantines a child then they will get asynchronous class and office hours with the teacher. It's unclear if this will be provided if a student is under quarantine from traveling, or family situations

 - Review protocol: Call 911 (the more calls the better). But please be mindful that you can only call for illegal activity (loitering is not illegal). Examples include: public drug use, indecent exposure, blocking sidewalk etc.
 - You do not need to stay until an officer shows up, but go report to school safely officer
 - Give your name and phone number
 - Don't call the school
 - Community Affairs Office is also helpful (212) 741-8226
 - There is apparently an unlocked port-a-potty at 21st and 8th (north side) Jackie and Lisa will look into whether it's supposed to be there
