Principal's Report - Bob Bender

- Construction update
 - Locker room update construction is progressing; completion is expected by September
 - Held initial meetings for the new playground there will be new equipment, flooring, and benches; won't be a lengthy project, and hope complete during one of the school breaks next school year
 - o PS 11 is turning 100 next year
- Teachers will be having planning meetings next week for building next year's curriculum
- 4th grade camping trip is coming up Need 1 or 2 more male chaperones. It would also be great to have a Spanish speaking chaperone, if possible
- Frozen rehearsals are taking place
- As part of the school-wide safety initiatives, we are required to have a certain number of staff trained in CPR response; 12 people are attending the training today

Parent Coordinator's Report - Stephen McGill

- Kindergarten GenEd and G&T offers are out
 - If your child has a Gen Ed or G&T Kindergarten offer, you must accept that seat in your MySchools account by May 5, or you will lose your seat, and the school must move to the waitlist
 - Current Pre-K students are NOT considered registered at PS 11 going to Kindergarten these families must also accept the formal Kindergarten offer
- G&T for 1st through 4th grade for next year if you would like to apply for a seat, you must do that via the DOE website
 - 1st 4th grade G&T spots for next year are not based on teacher recommendations you must apply. Seats are given based on availability and based on the first period of marking grades this year (i.e., for current Kindergarteners, the DOE will look at January report card grades and determine seats for 1st grade)



- Application period is May 2-15 for current K-3rd graders
- o Acceptances will be announced in June 2023

- SLT elections to take place during the June PTA meeting 2 seats available for next year
 - The School Leadership Team SLT is a collaborative team made up of an equal number of faculty and parents. Members include the Principal, Assistant Principal, UFT Representative, and PTA President (or their appointee) and our Community Based Organization (CBO) representative, in addition to five parent members and three elected members of the PS11 faculty.
 - The PS11 SLT has two primary responsibilities. One is to evaluate the academic needs of PS11 students and produce a Comprehensive Education Plan (CEP) that proposes ways to meet those needs, in alignment with the school budget for the following school year. The other is to monitor whether the current CEP is being implemented, and to ensure that proper resources are allocated to implement the current CEP
 - The SLT parent elections are held each June directly following the PTA EB elections. The term for each member is 2 years and requires a time commitment of one 2-hour meeting per month and several parent workshop events held at school throughout the year. Members should make every effort to attend all meetings and events, but may miss only 2 meetings per calendar year.
