- Welcome to the new families
- Introduction to the two Vice Principals, Dawn Rosevear (K-2nd grade) & Cassandra Gregov (3rd-5th grade)
- We are a KG&G school (Kind, Gentle & Grateful); Sarah J Garnett was a big practitioner of gratitude
- This year we have adopted 2 new curricula for phonics and math, UFLI
- We have implemented new lunch and recess protocols to make it more structured
 - Involves class colors for lunch and recess and correspond to color coded benches and bins for belongings
 - Structured recess play with different zones and staff members for each zone
- Gratitude for the PTA funding from families, which helps us fund all the programs we've already started:
 - 5th grade: Rosie's Theater Kids, puberty curriculum, have started planning the DC trip
 - In-school chess program has begun for 1st, 2nd and 3rd grade 10 wk cycles of chess instruction
 - 3rd grade farm market and upcoming farm field trip
- Construction update: PS 11 is turning 100 years old this year, construction is almost complete
 - Scaffolding is still in place on 20th street
 - Interior work is being done. The boys and girls locker rooms have been upgraded
 - Held design meeting for the new playground; hope to have it by September 2024

- Review September report and annual budget
- Majority of funding comes from Annual Fund, which is a key driver of being able to maintain programming
- We have 2 big fundraising events Gala and Comedy Show. We have many other fundraising and PTA sponsored programs
- Funding budget: includes field day, school dances, enrichment programs, chess, yearbook, community
 events, field trips (DC, camping, farm) we fund the majority of those expenses. We also cover things
 like lice checks and school supplies.
 - We are lucky we built up a reserve over the last couple of years. This allowed us to maintain our programs this year, but we are dipping into our reserves. Therefore, we need to keep up our fundraising this year
