# C. SLT Proposal: Math Team

- 1. Read proposal for Spring math enrichment for 3rd graders.
- 2. SLT liked proposal. SLT will be involved in process for selection (i.e. lottery).
- 3. Parent who made proposal can contact Bob for next steps.

#### D. CEP

- 1. Engaged in mid-point progress monitoring to see if we have met mid-point benchmarks highlighted in the CEP.
- 2. <u>Mid-Point Goal 1:</u> By February 2017, 100% of targeted students in grades K-2 who were assessed as reading below grade-level benchmarks in May 2016 will have moved 50% of expected growth.
- <u>Mid-Point Update:</u> Kindergarten is approaching mid-point goal, 1st grade is exceeding mid-point goal, 2nd grade is behind. Bob will review March data as the January data was based on December running records. We will assess if this changes progress results. Accordingly, Bob will review reading levels (J-K). Mid- year action plan for this goal will be altered accordingly.
- 4. <u>Mid-Point Goal 2 :</u> By February 2017, 100% of all classroom teachers will have participated in at least 14 cross-grade study group sessions
- 5. <u>Mid-Point Update 2:</u> Reached mid-point goal



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- 6. <u>Mid-point Goal 3</u>: By February 2017, 100% of teachers will have participated in at least three RTI professional development sessions.
- 7. <u>Mid-Point Update 3":</u> Teachers have done 2. Need to follow-up for dates and the schedule 2 more for the remainder of the year to meet annual goal of 4X.
- 8. <u>Mid-Point Goal 4:</u> By February 2017, all Reading, Writing, and Math units from September through February will have HOP content on the website.
- 9. <u>Mid-point Update 4:</u> Goal has been met. All content found on HOP website.
- 10. <u>Mid-point Goal 5</u>: By February 2017, 100% of classrooms will have implemented at least 6 shared experiences.
- 11. <u>Mid-Point Update 5</u>: Goal has been met.
