Minutes:

A. April meeting minutes approved.

B. Enrichment Proposal

- Proposal for kindergarten book exchange approved. No funds involved.
- When new PTA Executive Board convenes, remind them of the SLT proposal process.

C. SLT Elections

 Three two-year terms open for parents. Nominations open at May 18th PTA meeting and elections will be at the June 8th PTA meeting. Candidates do not have to be present at the meeting to run.

D. Swimming Open House

 Discussed how to give parents an opportunity to visit a swimming class. Possible option is to invite 2nd grade families to watch one session during the year since this is the grade where swimming is introduced at school.

F. Architecture Night

- Given the success of the school-wide bullying Family Friday, discussed the idea of more SLT-supported Family Fridays. Possibly two per year with school-wide theme but different content for K-2 and 3-5.
- One topic to consider for next year is Race Equity.

I. Comprehensive Education Plan

- June meeting will be to draft CEP. Two June meetings have been scheduled if necessary.

J. Extended School Day Research

- Ron Miller presented data on time in school and performance.
- Old data shows no correlations and new data shows correlation but flawed because there are many more variables.
- It seems extended day may be valuable to increase performance; however, it is not effective if extra material is added during the additional time.

K. Next Year SLT Events

- Discussed ideas of an event to add in lieu of of Architecture night
- Discussed bringing back food to meetings to bolster attendance
- Possible topics could be STEM, social/emotional, and/or racial equity related
- Discussed how to incorporate cultural celebrations to school culture appropriately

L. Safety
