- May 19, 2011 SLT Meeting Minutes approved
- DOE proposed move of PS51 students to PS11

We discussed DOE's ill-conceived proposal to move the upper grades of PS 51 to 320 West 21st Street for the upcoming 2011-2012 and 2012-2013 school years due to PS51 parents' concerns about health risks for their children due to local construction. This proposal is completely unacceptable. To absorb 150 students from PS51 (their 3/4/5 grades) will require that we turn over 8 rooms for their use. Where are these rooms? The DOE proposal would force us to uproot and crowd our neediest students - those in self-contained mixed-grade Special Education classes - into cramped 1/2 size rooms. In addition, we'd be forced to close our Science Lab (or Music Room or Art Room). All this while absorbing overflow from PS41 (30 offers were given for Fall 2011) and opening a 7th Kindergarten section to support the ever- growing demographic in Chelsea. There are so many logistical reasons why this proposal would prove a nightmare: aside from the obvious upheaval and overcrowding, where/when would these new students have lunch or recess?Art, Music, Computers? How would they have Science? How would we handle arrival and dismissal when their day is from 8:00-2:30, ours is 8:50-3:10? Not to mention the hugely wasteful financial cost of relocating them (and shuffling us, again), and an estimated 5 bus routes at \$80,000 per route. We are prepared to bring the full force of PS 11's SLT, parent body, and extended community to bear in opposition. We will not allow our children's education to be undermined by shortsightedness.

Kristin (SLT), Juan/Kathryn (PTA) and Vicki (PAC) will draft a letter to Ms. Rose of the DOE and cc other relevant organizations and individuals. Parent body will be informed.
